Policy 02 – Player Registration Terms & Conditions

Nomination to Join

At sign-on parents nominate their children, or themselves if players, to join the club. The club can accept or decline applications for up to one month after the date of sign on. Declined applications will receive a full refund within a reasonable period of time from the joining date.

What Do Fees Cover?

The Colleges United Soccer Club is a not-for-profit organisation. Yearly expenses are heavily subsidised by canteen operations and sponsorship. Registration fees cover the following:

- Association fees (Football Australia, Football Queensland, Football Brisbane)
- Basic player insurance & building and contents insurance
- Trophies and team photos
- Playing equipment including goals, nets, game balls, bibs, bags, cones, etc.
- Coaching and coaching Aids
- Building and grounds cleaning and maintenance
- Equipment capital expenditure and maintenance
- Electricity/utility costs
- Administrative costs
- Council rates and fees such as water
- Future fund

No Pay - No Play

All Registration Fees are due at sign-on. The Club has a policy of “no pay – no play” in fairness to the overwhelming majority who pay on time and the fact that registration fees have to be paid to the governing associations before player registrations can take effect.

Should it prove difficult for a player or parent/guardian to pay the total fee at sign-on time then they may be entitled to an alternative payment arrangement by agreement with the Management Committee.

De-registration/Refunds

All requests for refund of Registration Fees must be submitted in writing to the Club Secretary stating the reasons for the request. Such requests shall be considered by the Management Committee and a refund amount determined based upon the stage in the season the refund was requested.

Unregistered Players

Football Brisbane Inc policy is that unregistered players are **absolutely forbidden** to participate in training and/or games. Team officials are responsible for ensuring no unregistered players train or play.

Unfinancial Players

Under the “no pay – no play” policy, it would be rare for any of our players to be unfinancial. However, it should be noted that Football Brisbane maintains a register of those players who are unfinancial with their clubs and use this list to block any transfers of such players to other clubs.
